GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ACADEMIC POSITIONS

Candidates for the positions listed above must satisfy the following criteria as applicable:

1. PROFESSOR

Candidates should possess a Ph.D. degree in the appropriate discipline with at least Twelve (12) years of unbroken teaching and research experience in a University system. Candidates must have at least Twenty-eight (28) scholarly publications in both local and international journal, plus registration with relevant professional bodies where applicable. Candidates must also have sufficient administrative experience.

2. READER

Ph.D. degree in the appropriate discipline, with Nine (9) years of unbroken teaching and research experience in a University system or cognate exposure with demonstrable evidence of scholarly achievement and Twenty-one (21) scholarly publications. Candidates must also have sufficient administrative experience.

3. SENIOR LECTURER

Ph.D degree in the appropriate discipline, with Five (5) years teaching and research experience in a University plus Ten (10) scholarly publications, with at least Two (2) years as a Lecturer I. Candidates must also have sufficient administrative experience.

4. LECTURER I

Ph.D. degree in the appropriate discipline, with Three (3) years teaching and research experience in a University plus Three (3) publications, with at least Two (2) years as a Lecturer II or Ph.D with professional registration as applicable.

5. LECTURER II

Ph.D degree in the appropriate discipline or Master's degree in the appropriate discipline with three (3) years teaching and research experience in a University plus one (1) journal publications, or at least two (2) years as an Assistant Lecturer or M.Sc plus professional registration.

6. ASSISTANT LECTURER

Candidates should possess a Master's degree in the appropriate discipline; evidence of registration into Ph.D in any reputable University is an advantage.

7. GRADUATE ASSISTANT

Candidates should possess a good honours degree (First or Second Class Upper) in the appropriate discipline obtained from any recognized University. Evidence of enrollment into a Masters Programme in any reputable University is an advantage.

8. ACADEMIC LIBRARIAN

Candidates should possess a good Master's Degree in Library and Information Science or its equivalent from any recognized University and must be a registered Librarian with relevant professional registration

9. TECHNOLOGIST

Candidates must possess a good B.Sc./HND from a recognized institution in relevant. Professional Registration is an added advantage.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR NON-TEACHING POSITIONS

1.	Farm Manager: (CONTISS 13) A degree in Agriculture or a related discipline plus Eight (8) years of experience in Management of an Experimental Farm in a Higher Institute or an Agric Research Institute.
2.	Chief Accountant: (CONTISS 13) B.Sc Accounting with minimum grade of Second Class Lower Division with Twelve (12) years post qualification experience and literacy in Computer Applications. Possession of ICAN/ANAN Professional Accounting Qualification is mandatory.

3.	Assistant Director of Works (CONTISS 13) A degree in Engineering from a recognized Institution and must be registered with the Council of Engineers of Nigeria (COREN) with a minimum of Twelve (12) years post qualification cognate experience, most of which preferably should be in engineering services relevant to a University Works Department.
4.	Assistant Director of Physical Planning (CONTISS 13) B.Tech degree in Quantity Survey and must be a registered member of the Nigerian Institute of Quantity Surveyors (NIQS). Or a degree in Architecture from a recognized Institution and must be registered with the Architects Registration Council of Nigeria (ARCON) with a minimum of Twelve (12) years post qualification cognate experience, most of which preferably should be in engineering services relevant to a University Works Department.
5.	Principal Assistant Registrar: (CONTISS 13) A degree from a recognized institution with a minimum of second class lower division. Computer literacy and possession of SSCE/NECO/WAEC/GCE O' Level credits in five (5) subjects including English Language are required, plus at least Twelve (12) years post qualification experience in the public sector preferably in Higher Educational Institutions (Computer literacy is required). Membership of a Professional Body e.g Nigerian Institute of Management (NIM) will be an added advantage.
6.	Senior Assistant Registrar: (CONTISS 11) A degree from a recognized institution with a minimum of second class lower division. Computer literacy and possession of SSCE/NECO/WAEC/GCE O' Level credits in five (5) subjects including English Language are required, plus at least Nine (9) years post qualification experience in the public sector preferably in Higher Educational Institutions (Computer literacy is required). Membership of a Professional Body (e.g Nigerian Institute of Management, NIM) will be an added advantage
7.	Principal Accountant (CONTISS 11) B.Sc Accounting with minimum grade of Second Class Lower Division with Six (6) years post qualification experience and literacy in Computer Applications. Membership of a recognized professional accounting body (e.g ACA, ACCA, CPA, ACNA, ANAN, etc) will be an added advantage
8.	Principal Executive Officer Account: (CONTISS 11) B.Sc Accounting with minimum grade of Second Class Lower Division with Nine (9) years post qualification experience and literacy in Computer Applications. Membership of a recognized professional accounting body (e.g ACA, ACCA, CPA, ACNA, ANAN, etc) will be an added advantage.
9.	Principal Procurement Officer: (CONTISS 11) A Bachelors degree or its equivalent in Economics, Business Administration, Accountancy, Law, Banking and Finance, Marketing, Quantity Survey, Purchasing and Supply or any related discipline in a recognized Institution. Candidate must be computer literate, possess at least Twelve (12) years cognate experience and must have a good understanding of the Public Procurement Act, 2007 and its extant guidelines in Nigeria.
10.	Principal Internal Auditor: (CONTISS 11) A degree in Accountancy from a recognized University with Six (6) years post qualification experience and literacy in Computer Application. Possession of a professional qualification from any recognized accounting body will be an added advantage
11.	Assistant Registrar: (CONTISS 09) A degree from a recognized institution with a minimum of second class lower division. Computer literacy and possession of SSCE/NECO/WAEC/GCE O' Level credits in five (5) subjects including English Language are required, plus at least Six (6) years post qualification experience in the public sector preferably in Higher Educational Institutions (Computer literacy is required). Membership of a Professional Body (e.g Nigerian Institute of Management, NIM) will be an added advantage.
12.	Senior Accountant: (CONTISS 09) B.Sc Accounting with Eight (8) years post qualification experience. Possession of ICAN certification will be an added advantage
13.	Senior Executive Officer (Accounts): (CONTISS 08) B.Sc/HND degree in Account and A.C.I.S Certification, plus Three (3) years post qualification experience.
14.	Snr. Information & Public Relations Officer I (CONTISS 09) Bachelor degree in Linguistics and Communication Studies, English Studies or a related discipline with Six (6) years post qualification experience. Applicant should be computer literate and a be a Certified Member of the Professional body of Public Relation Officers.
15.	Accountant I: (CONTISS 08) B.Sc Accounting with minimum grade of Second Class Lower Division with Three (3) years post qualification experience and literacy in Computer Applications. Membership of a recognized professional accounting body (e.g ACA, ACCA, CPA, ACNA, ANAN, etc) will be an added advantage
16.	Administrative Officer I (CONTISS 08) A degree from a recognized institution with a minimum of second class lower division. Computer literacy and possession of SSCE/NECO/WAEC/GCE O' Level credits in five (5) subjects including English Language are required, plus at least three (3) years post qualification experience in the public sector preferably in Higher Educational Institutions (Computer literacy is required). Membership of a Professional Body (e.g Nigerian Institute of Management, NIM) will be an added advantage.
17.	Snr. Information & Public Relations Officer II (CONTISS 08) Bachelor degree in Linguistics and Communication Studies, English Studies or a related discipline with Three (3) years post qualification experience. Applicant should be computer literate and a be a Certified Member of the Professional body of Public Relation Officers.
18.	Legal Officer: (CONTISS 08) LLB degree with Two (2) years post qualification experience. Computer literacy is compulsory.
19.	Laboratory Technologist I (CONTISS 08) B.Sc/HND from a recognized institution with a minimum of lower credits. A Proficiency Certificate of N.I.S.T. is required.
20.	Senior Library Officer (CONTISS 08) Candidate should possess a good Honours Degree/HND in Library and Information Science plus Three (3) years cognate experience as Higher Library Officer.
21.	Data Processing Officer (CONTISS 08) Candidates must possess a degree in Computer Science/Data Processing from a recognized Institution with at least Three (3) years experience.
22.	Confidential Secretary: (CONTISS 07) HND in Secretarial Studies from a recognized Institution with Five (5) O'level credits in not more than two sittings, one of them being English language, plus PITMAN/RSA with 120/60 in typewriting and shorthand. Proficiency of ICT is required at the point of entry.
23.	Computer Analyst (CONTISS 07) National Diploma in Computer related courses / Secretarial Studies from a recognized Government Institution with Three (3) years post qualification experience, Five (5) O'level credits in not more than two (2) sittings, plus 50WPM in typewriting (PITMAN/RSA). Good knowledge of Disk/Tape Operating Systems, familiarity with computers and warm programming language.
24.	Library Officer I (CONTISS 07) Candidate should possess a good Honours Degree/ HND in Library and Information Science plus three(3) years cognate experience as Higher Library Officer.
